

USE THE BINS CORRECTLY

- Recommend bins out on night before collection day
- Bring the bin in after collection
- Do not overfill – lid must close
- Maximum weight 75kgs
- Ensure bins face the road with wheels towards the house



CORRECT BIN PLACEMENT – Where practical keep a minimum distance of 50cm between bins and 1m between bins and parked cars, letterboxes, stobie poles, overhanging trees etc.

CHECK THE COLLECTION BY DAY AND DATE

WHY Recover Food Organics and Green Organics (FOGO)?

FRWA Bin Audits show up to 44% of material in our general waste to landfill bins could have been composted or recycled in the **GREEN ORGANICS BIN**.

When food is wasted or disposed of in the landfill bin, we

- waste the fuel, energy and water used to produce and transport it
- increase landfill costs
- increase production of greenhouse gases

WHAT can I put in the GREEN ORGANICS BIN? ALL FOOD ORGANICS and GREEN ORGANICS (FOGO)

ALL FOOD SCRAPS and ORGANIC GARDEN WASTE

- ✓ fruit and vegetable peelings
- ✓ meat and bones
- ✓ poultry and seafood
- ✓ baked goods – bread, cakes and pastries
- ✓ tea bags and coffee grounds
- ✓ eggshells, pasta, rice and dairy products
- ✓ food soiled paper and card board including pizza boxes
- ✓ uneaten takeaway food
- ✓ garden cuttings, flowers, leaves and lawn clippings

FORTNIGHTLY KERBSIDE WASTE COLLECTION

- **COLLECTION DAY** – check collection map to confirm collection day, date, area and waste type
- **GENERAL WASTE** and **RECYCLING** collections are **FORTNIGHTLY** – alternating weekly
- **Green waste collections** (townships only) are **FORTNIGHTLY** – check your collection area for collection day and dates – **GREEN ORGANICS WASTE COLLECTION** may occur on a **DIFFERENT** day to the collection of general waste and recycling

COLLECTION CALENDAR	Kerbside Waste Collections occur by DATE – residents must place the correct bin out for collection in accordance with calendar by collection day, date, area and waste type.
BINS OUT	Recommend bins out night before collection day.
PUBLIC HOLIDAYS	KERBSIDE COLLECTIONS ON PUBLIC HOLIDAYS NO kerbside collections on CHRISTMAS DAY 2019 . Collection for Christmas Day, Wednesday 25 December 2019 will occur on Thursday 26 December 2019, with all further collections in this week moved forward by one day. All other kerbside collections will occur as usual on all public holidays in 2019-2020.
RURAL COLLECTIONS	Bin Banks - continue to use your current bin bank location. Rural Roadside Collection - continue to place your bins roadside for collection. Check your collection calendar for any change to collection day.
COMPOST EQUIPMENT	Compost Bins, worm farms and kitchen caddy kits are available for purchase from Kangaroo Island Council.
IDENTIFY YOUR BIN	House paint can be used to mark your bin with your street address or property name.
PUBLIC LITTER BINS (PLB)	PLBs will be to 240L maroon bins for easy identification.

IF IT GROWS IN IT GOES !

ALL food scraps – meat, bone, fat, baked goods and vegetable matter (in domestic quantities) is good to go in the green organic bin

WEDNESDAY – your collection day is **WEDNESDAY** for **GREEN ORGANIC WASTE ONLY**, if you live in the following collection area :

COLLECTION AREA 2	Kingscote and Brownlow (within township boundaries only and for properties of 2000m ² or less in size)
WASTE TYPE	G – Green Organic Waste (green lid bin)

SPECIAL NOTES

- Recommend bins out night before collection day

PUBLIC HOLIDAYS waste collection will occur as usual on all public holidays.

EXCEPTION CHRISTMAS DAY - no collection on Christmas Day, moving all collections one day forward to the next day
